Brief Criteria for Promotion to Senior Rank

All Academic faculty members are expected to demonstrate ongoing productivity and leadership in one or more of the following areas:

- Teaching
- Research
- Health Care and/or Service
- Mentoring (if applicable) of graduate students, junior faculty, residents, or students
- Other Academically-Related Professional Development (including program development and/or administration; developing service contracts;
 - Participation and leadership roles in substantive University, local, regional, national, and international committees)

The criteria for Promotion are demonstrated by:

Associate Professor

Evidence of steady growth in scholarly activity and leadership or excellence in one or more endeavors.

Professor

Evidence of sustained or increased scholarly activity, generally for a period of five years, and of leadership or excellence in many endeavors, including evidence of a national or international reputation in one's field.
